East Ayrshire Council has launched a new free digital television service called *EAC TV* which is available via the interactive button on your Sky remote. The service is also available through Virgin TV, your mobile phone, Nintendo Wii or your PC.

You can find out which schools or roads may be closed due to the winter weather; read the latest Council news; get ideas for days out in East Ayrshire; find out when the school holidays are and so much more. Information is also available on Jobcentre Plus, the NHS and Transport Direct. The service will be regularly updated and new features added in the New Year.

Councillor Douglas Reid, Leader of the Council, said: *"One of the best features of this service is that you can access information about an extensive range of Council services whether you're sitting on your sofa at home or if you're out and about with your mobile. It couldn't be easier and I hope that it will provide people with valuable information, particularly over the winter period with the potential problems that can arise at this time of year!"*
